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


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- i. Project Authority will ensure that personal protective equipments such as protective clothing, helmet, goggles or other garments or equipments designed to protect from injury or infection will be provided to working personnel's.
- ii. The environmental clearance shall be valid subject to extension of lease deed and will be co-terminus of lease granted.
- iii. The production shall be restricted as per approved mining scheme or the approved mine plan at the time of EC granted by then DEIAA, which ever is less.
- iv. The mine will come in operation only after obtaining permission from DGMS for controlled and delayed blasting.
- v. 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

I. Proposed Residential Complex namely "The Skyline" of Dhatre Udyog Limited, Village : Dindli, Tehsil : Gamharia, Distt. : Saraikela - Kharsawan, Jharkhand (Proposal no.: SIA/JH/ INFRA2 /535335 /2025).

SEAC has appraised the above project and made unanimous recommendations for grant of Environmental Clearance to above mentioned project proposal. The SEIAA, based on the recommendations of SEAC, unanimously decided to grant Environmental Clearance to the above mentioned project proposal with the conditions recommended by SEAC and alongwith the following specific conditions:

- i. In compliance of OM No. F. No. IA3-22/3/2024-IA.III (E-241594) dated 24.07.2024 of MoEF&CC, Govt. of India plantation of saplings shall be carried out in the earmarked green belt area as the part of tree plantation campaign "Ek Ped Ma Ke Naam" and the details of the same shall be uploaded in the MeriLiFE Portal (<https://merilife.nic.in>). 10% of the total green belt proposed shall be allocated under this clause.
- ii. PAs shall construct a 3-meter-high boundary wall using hollow clay bricks alongwith thick plantation of minimum 3 rows as an effective noise barrier on side facing industrial area.
- iii. Two to four rows of plantation will be developed along the boundary, as a natural barrier against airborne dust and noise.
- iv. Ground water to be drawn for use in the project only after obtaining permission from the Competent Authority.
- v. Environment management system including organization structure to be drawn to ensure compliance of EC conditions stipulated based on principles of Continual Improvement and periodical management review.

SEAC has appraised the above project and made unanimous recommendations for grant of Environmental Clearance to above mentioned project proposal. The SEIAA, based on the recommendations of SEAC, unanimously decided to grant Environmental Clearance to the above mentioned project proposal with the conditions recommended by SEAC and alongwith the following specific conditions:

- i. In compliance of OM no. F. No. IA3-22/3/2024-IA.III (E-241594) dated 24.07.2024 of MoEF&CC, Govt. of India plantation of saplings shall be carried out in the earmarked green belt area as the part of tree plantation campaign “*Ek Ped Ma Ke Naam*” and the details of the same shall be uploaded in the MeriLiFE Portal (<https://merilife.nic.in>). 10% of the total green belt proposed shall be allocated under this clause.
- ii. Maximum quantity of Rain Water Harvested shall be used within the plant premises and only surplus RWH water shall be recharged to ground.
- iii. No effluent to be discharged out side the plant premises.
- iv. Ground water to be drawn for use in the project only after obtaining permission from the Competent Authority.

9. SEIAA considered the recommendations made by SEAC in its 127<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 09<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> October, 2025 for withdraw/delist of following Minor Mineral (Stone Mining) project:

- 1. Deoria Stone Deposit of M/s Sri Ganesh Stone Mines & Crusher (Partner : Shri Nand Kishore Prasad & Shri Santosh Kumar Choubey), Mouza : Deoria, Anchal : Daru, Thana no. : 126, Distt. : Hazaribag, Jharkhand (1.197 Ha) (Proposal no.: SIA/JH/MIN/ 552172 /2025).

The SEAC considered the above mentioned project for appraisal and forwarded following recommendation to SEIAA in this matter:

*"The PAs vide letter dated 09.10.2025 requested for withdrawal of the proposal".*

*Hence, the Committee recommends the project may be delisted".*

SEIAA examined the recommendation made by SEAC in above mentioned project proposal and after full deliberations, it was unanimously decided to accept the recommendation made by SEAC to delist the above project proposal from PARIVESH portal with immediate effect.

10. Transfer of Environmental Clearance regarding.

- 1. Chandradipa Stone Mine of M/s Sri Balajee Minerals Corporation (Partner : Shri Anant Prasad), Village : Chandradipa, Tehsil : Mihijam, Distt. : Jamtara, Jharkhand (0.931 Ha) (Proposal no.: SIA/JH/MIN/ 553937 /2025).

The SEAC examined the above project proposal in the light of O.M. No. IA3-22/19/2023-IA.III(E226246), dated 03.11.2023 of MoEF & CC, Govt. of India and unanimously made following recommendation:

*"The above mentioned project was considered in the light of section 11 of EIA Notification, 2006 and OM no. IA3-22/19/2023-IA.III [E-226246], dated 03.11.2023 of MoEF&CC, Govt. of India for transferability of Environmental Clearance. The Environmental Clearance granted by SEIAA vide its letter no. EC/SEIAA/2025-26/3814/2025/289, dated 23.07.2025 in the favour of Chandradipa Stone Mine of M/s Sanjit Hembram (Partner: Shri Amrendra Tiwari) on plot no. 625(p) and 569(p), Khata no. 102, Village: Chandradipa, Anchal: Jamtara, Distt.: Jamtara, Jharkhand (0.931 Ha).*

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The proposal number vide online application no. SIA/JH/MIN/553937/2025 has requested to transfer of Environmental Clearance for Chandradipa Stone Mine of M/s Sanjit Hembram (Partner : Shri Amtrendra Tiwari) for which he has submitted "No Objection Certificate" affirming that the Environmental Clearance will be transfer in favour of "Chandradipa Stone Mine of M/s Sri Balajee Minerals Corporation (Partner : Shri Anant Prasad)" and they do not have any objection regarding the transfer of Environmental Clearance and all the terms & conditions of Environmental Clearance dated 23.07.2025 shall be complied by Chandradipa Stone Mine of M/s Sri Balajee Minerals Corporation (Partner : Shri Anant Prasad). Deputy Commissioner, Jamtara dated 13.08.2024 ordered for transfer of lease to Sri Balajee Minerals Corporation.

The DMO, Jamtara also certify vide letter no. 600/M, dated 22.08.2024 that production is within the overall permissible production limit.


It is observed that Deputy Commissioner, Jamtara issued a transfer order on 13.08.2024 in the name of Chandradipa Stone Mine of M/s Sri Balajee Minerals Corporation (Partner : Shri Anant Prasad) and as per direction of OM no. IA3-22/19/2023-IA.III [E-226246], dated 03.11.2023 of MoEF&CC, Govt. of India application for transfer of EC after a period of twelve months but within twenty-four months from the date of change in transfer in company or name the delay shall be condoned at the level of the Minister incharge of MoEF, Govt. of India or Chairman or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee as the case may be.

The PAs have also provided detailed justification to SEAC stating that the mines has not been in operation since 2020-2021 as per production certified by District Mining Officer, Jamtara vide letter no. 600/M dated – 22.08.2024 until the present period.

The delay in submitting the proposal for transfer of Environmental Clearance arose due to the time required for completing the statutory formalities related to lease transfer approval, issuance of production certificates, re-appraisal of the existing EC, and finalization of the updated District Survey Report (DSR). All these steps were necessary prerequisites before filing the EC transfer application through the PARIVESH portal.

Accordingly, SEAC accepted the justification and recommends for condonation of the reason of delay in the process of re-appraisal of Environmental Clearance issued vide letter no. 47/DEIAA, dated 26.11.2016 of Chandradipa Stone Mine of M/s Sanjit Hembrom (Partner: Shri Amrendra Tiwari). This re-appraisal of EC held on 23.06.2025 for the same proponent. After getting EC vide letter no. EC/SEIAA/2025-26/3814/2025/289 dated – 23.07.2025 the same was filed for transfer of EC on the name of M/s Sri Balajee Minerals Corporation (Partner: Shri Anant Prasad) with the same terms & condition under which prior Environmental Clearance was granted by SEIAA for the same validity period".

Hence, SEIAA unanimously decided to accept the recommendations of SEAC, that Environmental Clearance issued vide letter no. EC/SEIAA/2025-26/3814/2025/289 dated – 23.07.2025 is being transferred to "Chandradipa Stone Mine of M/s Sri Balajee Minerals Corporation (Partner : Shri Anant Prasad)" with the same terms



and conditions under which prior Environmental Clearance was granted by SEIAA, Jharkhand for the same validity period subject to satisfactory compliance to all stipulated terms and conditions. “Chandradipa Stone Mine of M/s Sri Balajee Minerals Corporation (Partner : Shri Anant Prasad)” is directed to obtain Consent to Operate from the State Pollution Control Board in the name of “Chandradipa Stone Mine of M/s Sri Balajee Minerals Corporation (Partner : Shri Anant Prasad)” In case any change is proposed in the Scope of the project, the Project Authority (PA) shall obtain fresh Environmental Clearance.

- II. **Borna Stone Mine of M/s Krishna Stone (Prop. : Shri Rakesh Ranjan), Village : Bona, Thana : Ranga, Distt. : Sahibganj, Jharkhand (3.385 Ha) (Proposal no.: SIA/JH/MIN/ 553492 /2025).**

The SEAC examined the above project proposal in the light of O.M. No. IA3-22/19/2023-IA.III(E226246), dated 03.11.2023 of MoEF & CC, Govt. of India and unanimously made following recommendation:

*“The above mentioned project was considered in the light of section 11 of EIA Notification, 2006 and OM no. IA3-22/19/2023-IA.III [E-226246], dated 03.11.2023 of MoEF&CC, Govt. of India for transferability of Environmental Clearance. The Environmental Clearance granted by then SEIAA, Jharkhand vide its letter no. EC/SEIAA/2024-25/3564/2024/700, dated 20.03.2025 in the favor of Borna Stone Mine of M/s Dev Black Stone Works, (Prop.:Shri Rajesh Kumar Roshan) on plot no. 273, 299, 417, 418, 419, 420, 421,422, 432 & 433, Khata no. 24, 44, 52, 58 & 65, Village: Borna, Thana: Ranga, Distt. : Sahibganj, Jharkhand (3.385 Ha).*

*The PAs vide online application no. SIA/JH/MIN/553492/2025 has requested to transfer of Environmental Clearance Borna Stone Mine of M/s Dev Black Stone Works, (Prop.:Shri Rajesh Kumar Roshan) for which he has submitted “ No Objection Certificate” affirming that the Environmental Clearance will be transferred in favor of “Borna Stone Mine of M/s Krishna Stone (Prop.: Rakesh Ranjan)” and they do not have any objection regarding the transfer of Environmental Clearance all the terms & conditions of Environmental Clearance dated 20.03.2025 shall be complied by Borna Stone Mine of M/s Krishna Stone (Prop.: Rakesh Ranjan). Deputy Commissioner, Sahibganj vide GRN no. 2320621955, dated 16.12.2023 for the period of 29.11.2023 to 31.07.2026 for an area 8.36 Acre or 3.385 Ha.*

*The DMO, Sahibganj also certify vide memo no. 1031/M, dated 06.06.2025 that the said project falls under grid no. 117 and production is within the overall permissible production limit.*

*It is observed that Deputy Commissioner, Sahibganj transferred the lease deed in the name of Borna Stone Mine of M/s Krishna Stone (Prop.: Rakesh Ranjan) and as per direction of OM no. IA3-22/19/2023-IA.III [E-226246], dated 19.02.2025 of MoEF&CC, Govt. of India application for transfer of EC before the period of 24 months from the date of transfer / acquisition/ demerger / change in name etc. of the*

company, the PAs shall apply on PARIVESH Portal with detailed justification for delay in applying for transfer of EC.

The PAs have also provided detailed justification to SEAC. The PAs were also not aware as to whether the transfer of EC would be undertaken prior to re-appraisal DEIAA ECs.

The PAs stated that they have initiated the process of re-appraisal of DEIAA EC and transfer of EC after approval of updated DSR in 120th meeting of SEIAA held on 28th and 29th January, 2025 based on the recommendation of SEAC.



Accordingly, SEAC accepted the justification and recommends for condonation of the reason of delay in the process of transfer of Environmental Clearance issued vide letter no. EC/SEIAA/2024-25/3564/2024/700, dated 20.03.2025 in favor of Borna Stone Mine of M/s Krishna Stone (Prop.: Rakesh Ranjan) with the same terms & condition under which prior Environmental Clearance was granted by then SEIAA, Jharkhand for the same validity period".

Hence, SEIAA unanimously decided to accept the recommendations of SEAC, that Environmental Clearance issued vide letter no. EC/SEIAA/2024-25/3564/2024/700, dated 20.03.2025 is being transferred to "Borna Stone Mine of M/s Krishna Stone (Prop. : Shri Rakesh Ranjan)" with the same terms and conditions under which prior Environmental Clearance was granted by SEIAA, Jharkhand for the same validity period subject to satisfactory compliance to all stipulated terms and conditions. "Borna Stone Mine of M/s Krishna Stone (Prop. : Shri Rakesh Ranjan)" is directed to obtain Consent to Operate from the State Pollution Control Board in the name of "Borna Stone Mine of M/s Krishna Stone (Prop. : Shri Rakesh Ranjan)" In case any change is proposed in the Scope of the project, the Project Authority (PA) shall obtain fresh Environmental Clearance.

- III. **M/s Adani Power (Jharkhand) Limited to M/s Adani Power Limited** of Residential Township of operational 2X800 MW Coal based Godda Thermal Power Project at Village : Motia, District : Godda, Jharkhand (Proposal no.: SIA/JH/INFRA2/ 551406 /2025).

The above mentioned project proposal was considered in the light of section 11 of Environment Impact Assessment Notification, 2006 for transferability of Environmental Clearance. The Environmental Clearance was granted by SEIAA, Jharkhand vide letter no. EC/SEIAA/2017-18/2070/2017/207, dated 31.08.2018 in the favor of "Residential Township for 2x800 MW Thermal Power Project of M/s Adani Power (Jharkhand) Ltd. at Patwa Plot No. : 359, Motia Plot No. : 2622, 2570 to 2590 at Village : Motia & Patwa, Tehsil - Godda, District : Godda, Jharkhand."

The applicant vide online application no. SIA/JH/INFRA2/ 551406 /2025 has requested to transfer (transfer of ownership) of Environmental Clearance in favour of "M/s Adani Power Limited" for which he has submitted "No Objection Certificate" affirming that the Environmental Clearance will be transferred in favour of "M/s



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*Adani Power Limited*” and they do not have any objections regarding the transfer of Environmental Clearance and all the terms and conditions of Environmental Clearance dated 31.08.2018 shall be complied by “*M/s Adani Power Limited*”.

Hon’ble National Company Law Tribunal, Bench at Ahmedabad (“NCLT”) has pronounced its order on 4<sup>th</sup> April, 2025, sanctioning the Scheme of Amalgamation of Adani Power (Jharkhand) Limited ( a wholly owned subsidiary of APL) with Adani Power Limited. **The Scheme became effective from 25<sup>th</sup> April 2025** and consequently, APJL stands amalgamated with **Adani Power Limited**. The Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Govt. of India has also approved the change of name on conversion to Public Limited Company vide Corporate Identity Number: U40100GJ1996PLC030533.

After the full deliberations, it was unanimously decided that Environmental Clearance issued vide letter no. EC/SEIAA/2017-18/2070/2017/207, dated 31.08.2018 is being transferred to “*M/s Adani Power Limited*” with the same terms and conditions under which prior Environmental Clearance was granted by SEIAA, Jharkhand for the same validity period subject to satisfactory compliance to all stipulated terms and conditions. “*M/s Adani Power Limited*” is directed to obtain **Consent to Operate** from the State Pollution Control Board in the name of “*M/s Adani Power Limited*” In case any change is **proposed** in the **Scope** of the project, the Project Authority (PA) shall **obtain** fresh **Environmental Clearance**.

- IV. **Khora Brick Earth Mining for M/s Sahu Bricks (Prop. : Shri Virendra Sahu),** Mouza : Khora, Thana : Gumla, Thana No. 77, Distt. : Gumla, Jharkhand (1.573 Ha) (Proposal no.: SIA/JH/MIN/ 554260 /2025).

The above mentioned project proposal was considered in the light of section 11 of Environment Impact Assessment Notification, 2006 for transferability of Environmental Clearance. The Environmental Clearance was granted by SEIAA, **Jharkhand** vide letter no. EC/SEIAA/2023-24/3027/2023/424, dated 02.11.2023 in the favor of “**Khora Brick Earth Mining for M/s Sahu Bricks (Prop. : Shri Satyanarayan Sahu)** at Village : Khora, Tehsil : Gumla, Distt. : Gumla, Jharkhand (1.573 Ha)” (Proposal No. : SIA/JH/MIN/448737/2023)”.

The applicant vide online application no. SIA/JH/MIN/ 554260 /2025 has requested to transfer (transfer of ownership) of Environmental Clearance in favour of “*M/s Sahu Bricks (Prop. : Shri Virendra Sahu)*” for which he has submitted “No Objection Certificate” affirming that the Environmental Clearance will be transferred in favour of “*M/s Sahu Bricks (Prop. : Shri Virendra Sahu)*” and they do not have any objections regarding the transfer of Environmental Clearance and all the terms and conditions of Environmental Clearance dated 02.11.2023 shall be complied by “*M/s Sahu Bricks (Prop. : Shri Virendra Sahu)*”.

After the full deliberations, it was unanimously decided that Environmental Clearance issued vide letter no. EC/SEIAA/2023-24/3027/2023/424, dated 02.11.2023 is being transferred to “*M/s Sahu Bricks (Prop. : Shri Virendra Sahu)*” with the same terms



and conditions under which prior Environmental Clearance was granted by SEIAA, Jharkhand for the same validity period subject to satisfactory compliance to all stipulated terms and conditions. “M/s Sahu Bricks (Prop. : Shri Virendra Sahu)” is directed to obtain Consent to Operate from the State Pollution Control Board in the name of “M/s Sahu Bricks (Prop. : Shri Virendra Sahu)” In case any change is proposed in the Scope of the project, the Project Authority (PA) shall obtain fresh Environmental Clearance.

11. Updated District Survey Report (DSR) for Minor Minerals other than Sand Mining or River Bed Mining (Stone) to be approved on Latehar District:

I. Updated District Survey Report (Stone) of Latehar District

After Technical presentation before SEAC and appraisal of Final DSR, the unanimous recommendation was sent to SEIAA for approval of Updated District Survey Report for Minor Minerals other than Sand Mining or River Bed Mining (Stone) of **Latehar** district which are as follows:

*“The updated DSR was submitted by Deputy Commissioner, Latehar. He was represented by Md. Nadeem Shafi, District Mining Officer, Latehar at the SEAC meeting on 10.10.2025.*

*During the meeting the DMO, Latehar presented the DSR before the Committee. The DSR was appraised in light of S.O. no. 3611 (E), dated 25.07.2018 of MoEF&CC, Govt. of India.*

*The updated DSR had been placed in the public domain for 21 days from the 02.07.2025. As per the Sub Divisional Committee no comments / observations were received.*

*The DSR has been prepared as per the format provided in the above notification. The DSR submitted has been approved by the Sub-Divisional Committee. All the aspects of the notification dated 25.07.2018 are incorporated in the DSR and found to be satisfactory.*

***Hence, the updated DSR for Minor Minerals other than Sand Mining or River Bed Mining (Stone) of District Latehar is recommended to SEIAA for approval”.***

In the light of the recommendations of SEAC for approval of Updated District Survey Report for Minor Minerals other than Sand Mining or River Bed Mining (Stone) of **Latehar** district, the same was considered in the 127<sup>th</sup> meeting of SEIAA, Jharkhand on 04.11.2025 and 05.11.2025.

The SEIAA, unanimously, decided to approve the Updated District Survey Report (DSR) for Minor Minerals other than Sand Mining or River Bed Mining (Stone) of **Latehar** district on the basis **recommendations** of SEAC. It was also decided that a copy of approved Updated District Survey Report of Stone should be sent to the concerned Deputy Commissioner for onward necessary actions.



12. **Site Inspection Report of M/s Shankar Stone Mines, Partner : Shri Manoj Kumar Mehta and Shri Santosh Mehta, Village : Shankardih, Distt. : Giridih, Jharkhand in the light of Hon'ble NGT order dated 30.07.2025 in the matter of OA no. 113/2024/EZ, Amar Kumar Gupta vs The State of Jharkhand.**

The SEAC considered the contents of Hon'ble NGT order dated 30.07.2025 in the matter of OA no. 113/2024/EZ, Amar Kumar Gupta vs The State of Jharkhand and unanimously made its reply after due diligence and forwarded its Site Inspection Report to SEIAA vide SEAC letter no. 27, dated 18.10.2025.

The SEIAA agreed with the Site Inspection Report of SEAC made in the light of Hon'ble NGT order dated 30.07.2025 in the matter of OA no. 113/2024/EZ, Amar Kumar Gupta vs The State of Jharkhand and unanimously decided to forward the Site Inspection Report with all it's enclosures to the Member Secretary, Jharkhand State Pollution Control Board (JSPCB) for onward necessary actions and compliances.

13. **Makandu Stone Mine of M/s Safari Stone Works at New Khata No.: 287, Plot No. : 1223(P) and Old Khata No. : 128, Plot No. : 1171/P at Village : Makandu, Thana : Kuru, Distt.: Lohardaga, Jharkhand (1.21 Ha).**

The SEIAA considered the opinion of SEAC made in this regard and after proper deliberation and due diligence it has been observed that present proposal have been applied online through PARIVESH Portal 2.0 for grant of EC after issuance of ToR.

Earlier SEIAA has written a letter to Deputy Commissioner, Lohardaga and District Mining Officer, Lohardaga vide memo no. 144, dated 12.07.2024 to take appropriate action against the Project Proponent for submitting the wrong certificates under the relevant Acts and Rules, the action taken report and opinion of Deputy Commissioner, Lohardaga is yet to be submitted. At this stage SEIAA is of the opinion that SEAC may obtain the action taken report and opinion of Deputy Commissioner, Lohardaga directly and based upon the action taken report and opinion received from Deputy Commissioner, Lohardaga, the SEAC will proceed accordingly as per law.

14. **Monitoring of Six (06) Monthly Compliance Report – Regarding.**


The SEIAA considered the Mechanism of Monitoring of Six (06) Monthly Compliance Report submitted to Regulatory Authority in the light of EIA Notification, 2006 issued by MoEF & CC, Govt. of India and it was unanimously decided that following condition should be incorporated in every Environmental Clearance of Category 'B' project proposals:




"It shall be mandatory for the project management to submit six (06) monthly compliance report in respect of the stipulated prior Environmental Clearance terms and conditions in hard copies and soft copies to the regulatory authority concerned Regional Office of MoEF & CC at Ranchi and Jharkhand State Pollution Control Board (J.S.P.C.B.), Ranchi / CPCB as per direction contained in EIA Notification, 2006 and as amended vide OM No. J-11013/5/2009-IA.II dated : 29.06.2010, OM No. F.No.J-11013/5/2011-IA.I dated : 05.08.2011 and letter No. J-11013/71/2016-IA I(M) dated : 25.10.2017 of MoEF & CC, Govt. of India".
