*"54. The Deputy Commissioner, Palamau while doing so will call upon a report from SEIAA regarding the position of the Environmental Clearance based upon the measurement already made by the Revenue Authority."*



In the light of above, the Deputy Commissioner, Palamu seek the report from SEIAA, Jharkhand vide her/his letter no. 2845/M, dated 05.12.2025.

The Project Authority / Petitioner also submitted its representation vide letter dated 20.11.2025 and dated 06.01.2026 in the office of SEIAA, Jharkhand.

The SEIAA considered the facts and documents available in this regard and after perusal of the same SEIAA is of the view that:-

1. The Environmental Clearance to the said projects was issued by then DEIAA, Palamu vide its letter no. EC/DEIAA/2016-17/55, dated 17.08.2017 based upon the certificate issued by then Divisional Forest Officer, Medininagar Forest Division vide its letter no. 2381, dated 11.07.2016 and certificate issued by then Circle Officer, Patan, Palamu vide its letter no. 170, dated 13.05.2016 which reflects that the nearest forest is available at a distance of 300 meter.
2. The re-appraisal of said project was done by SEAC in its 119<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 17<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> December, 2024 in the light of OM No. F.No. IA3-22/11/2013-IA.III (E-208230), dated 28<sup>th</sup> April, 2023 of MoEF & CC, Govt. of India by which direction has been issued that all concerned SEACs shall re-appraise the ECs issued by DEIAAs between 15.07.2016 and 13.09.2018 (including both dates) and all fresh ECs in this regard shall be granted by SEIAA based on such appraisal. The re-appraisal done by SEAC, Jharkhand in the light of all the mandatory and essential documents including the forest distance certificates issued by then Divisional Forest Officer, Medininagar Forest Division, Palamu vide its letter no. 2381, dated 11.07.2016 and certificate issued by the Revenue Authority i.e. Circle Officer, Patan, Palamu vide its letter no. 170, dated 13.05.2016, which shows that nearest Forest is available at a distance of 300 meter. After the re-appraisal recommendation was made to SEIAA, Jharkhand and accordingly the said project was examined by the SEIAA in its 119<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2024 and decided to grant of Environmental Clearance based on recommendation of SEAC and other mandatory certificates / documents and Environmental Clearance was issued by SEIAA letter no. EC/SEIAA/2024-25/3404/2024/536, dated 13.01.2025.
3. The Environmental Clearance issued by SEIAA vide letter no. EC/SEIAA/2024-25/3404/2024/536, dated 13.01.2025 has not been withdrawn and is still valid.
4. The decision of SEIAA shall be communicated to Deputy Commissioner, Palamu with copy to Project Authority.

**17. Regarding undertaking site visit by SEIAA & SEAC.**

The Hon'ble Jharkhand High Court at Ranchi passed an order dated 13.11.2025 in the matter of W.P (PIL) No. 2026 of 2021, Anurag Kumar Rai & Anr Vs State of Jharkhand & Ors and following direction has been given to SEIAA / SEAC :-

*" 3. It is not in dispute that SEIAA has been constituted in terms of the notification vide S.O. No. 1533(E) dated 14.09.2006 issued by the Ministry of Environment and Forest, Government of India and in terms of Clause-2 thereof, the SEIAA has been held to be the*

concerned regulatory authority for the matters falling under Category 'B' in the schedule to the notification. In terms of Clause-10 of the said notification, which relates to 'Post Environmental Clearance Monitoring', it has been clearly provided that "It shall be mandatory for the project management to submit half-yearly compliance reports in respect of the stipulated prior environmental clearance terms and conditions in hard and soft copies to the regulatory authority concerned, on 1st June and 1st December of each calendar year".

4. It is candidly admitted by the respondent no. 8 that no such report has been submitted by the project managements and henceforth, she would be calling for all these reports so as to take appropriate action in the matter in case the project managements have been found to be either wanting or found to be violating any of the environmental clearance terms and conditions."


The site visit is very often essential and mandatory as per requirement / comments of AG Audit, Hon'ble Court direction, complaints receipt from various sources or any other such situation.

As per Department of Forest, Environment & Climate Change, Govt. of Jharkhand vide Notification no. 7/पर्यावरण-29/2015- 3392/वंप dated 10.08.2018 the allowances and sitting fee is remunerated to the Chairman, Members of SEIAA and SEAC during meetings only. However under the order dated 13.11.2025 in the matter of W.P. (PIL) No. 2026 of 2021 passed by Hon'ble Jharkhand High Court, such Site Visits are not being undertaken as there is no provisions for Honorarium and TA for such Site Visits. As the Chairman and Members of SEIAA and SEAC are not salaried employees of any Government Department or no provisions have been provided in this regard. Hence, Secretary, Department of Forest, Environment & Climate Change, Govt. of Jharkhand is requested that necessary notification be issued as deemed fit in this regard so that direction of Hon'ble Court may be complied. The Chairman and Members of SEIAA and SEAC are of the view that the sitting fee and other logistics facilities should be at par with the provisions mentioned in the Notification no. 7/पर्यावरण-29/2015- 3392/वंप dated 10.08.2018. It is also requested that two vehicles be provided for smooth functioning of SEIAA / SEAC.
